The Artist Conversation series continues on Saturday, June 18<sup>th</sup> at 1:00pm. Volume 3 features artists and gallery owners David Graham and Terri Warpinski, with special guest moderator, artist Carol Emmons. They will delve into their current exhibition, *From the Vault*, on view in their Sidedoor Gallery.

Graham's contribution features selected photographs from his 2003 book *Alone Together*. These intriguing photographs are an intimate look at the life of the Kellams who spent their last 40 years as the solitary inhabitants of Placentia Island off the coast of Maine. Grahams sensitive imaging shows every cup, book, and letter exactly where the Kellams left them, speaking to the deep love of two people for each other and for the natural beauty around them unburdened by excess or abundance, and answer questions from the audience.

Warpinski is featuring a 2018 collaboration with Portland, Oregon poet Laura Winter. *Liminal Matter: Traces* is a limited-edition portfolio box set of 15 image and text broadsides focused on the plight of the people caught between two nations along the US-Mexican border. These poetic pairings reveal through artifacts and evidence, the hopes, struggles and harsh realities of those in flight for the well-being of their families.

These are two powerful bodies of work and an abundance of anecdotes to go along with them. This is the first time the two have shared from their extensive repertoire of past projects – and the conversation is certain to be lively!

The gallery will be open from 12 - 3. Entry is always free and open to the public. Come early and take in the art on the walls! Also on view is the exhibition *Creative Power*, organized by Arts for All.WI. This exhibition, comprised of award-winning artworks and poetry created by Wisconsin children and adults with disabilities, is featured in the Storefront Gallery.
